What to bring		
Students will need to pack lunch and snacks for the first day. The cost includes all other meals, accommodation and all of the activities that we will take part in.

Personal Items Backpack, 1 plastic garbage bag, toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc), sleeping bag, pillow, water bottle.	Optional Extras A small amount of money not exceeding \$30. This will need to be placed in a sealed envelope with students name and class. Envelopes will be distributed at appropriate spending times.
Medication If your child requires medication please hand to your child's class teacher. Needs to be clearly labeled with name, class, dosage and time to be taken.	What NOT to bring Ipods/MP3s, radios, jewellery, mobile phones, mini computer games, make up, lollies. If these items are brought they will be confiscated and returned to parents upon arrival.	Expectations In accordance with the schools Core Values students attending this excursion must be on their best behaviour at all times. Students may be asked to contact their parents and sit out of activities if deemed necessary.

Please complete the attached medical consent form. It is important that the form is correctly filled in stating your child's needs. The dietary section must also be completed and must be returned to school no later than Friday 24th March, 2023.

We need to collate and pass on all the information to bus companies and food providers so we cannot make allowances to this form.
