



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

Mayor Joanna Gash Visits Cambewarra Public School

Shoalhaven's Mayor, Ms Joanna Gash visited Stage 3 students last Thursday as a follow up to their Canberra excursion earlier this term.

Ms Gash began by remarking how highly regarded Cambewarra School is in the Shoalhaven community. The children felt very proud of their school with this comment.

Mayor Gash told the students of her life in Australia as a young immigrant from Holland, and how she always wanted to help others.



She was very candid with her evaluation of her performance as Member for Gilmore including some of the mistakes she has made in her 17 years in office. She also told how proud she was of her many achievements during her term as Member, and the many important people she has met (including the Queen, Barack Obama, world leaders and eight Australian Prime Ministers).

Ms Gash answered all the children's questions in a personal manner and her visit was very well received. As a parting question Ms Gash asked the students who would like to become a politician. The response was rather luke warm: only 2 boys and 1 girl...maybe!!
