# Child Care Subsidy

On enrolment, Customer Reference Numbers (CRN) for parent/carer and child can be entered. This enables our service to link up to Centrelink. Please note children have their own unique CRN to their parent/carer. CRNs are 9 digits followed by a letter e.g. 234567891 X.

From 2 July 2018, the Government introduced the new Child Care Subsidy (CCS). Peak Sports and Learning is an approved child care service and our fees are reducible by Child Care Subsidy reductions provided by the Government. Families who haven't been assessed for CCS can complete their assessment through their online myGov account.

The amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get depends on your circumstances. Factors considered are:

- Your family's income
- The hourly cap based on primary school aged care
- The hours of activity you and your partner do

It is the parent/carer's responsibility to apply for these subsidies and to ensure they have a current assessment notice. Failure to comply with the Family Assistance office will result in full fees being charged.

Once Peak Sports & Learning receives an enrolment you need to confirm the enrolment details. Our Administration team can provide estimates based on the information available.

## All About Education

Peak Sports and Learning's tuition program has strong ties with current Department of Education & Communities curriculum's and syllabus outcomes. This allows your child to practice and gain feedback from qualified staff on current outcomes that they will be studying at school.

You are encouraged to talk to Peak Sports and Learning's Educators in regard to your child's current academic levels. Your child is encouraged to bring homework, projects or a home reader to Peak. If homework is brought to the centre, children will complete their homework under the guidance of qualified staff.

Our afternoon structure includes a rotation where the children will do any homework or home reading with our staff. If your child does not have any tasks that have been bought home we have our own Peak work booklets that they can complete depending on their current school year and term!



**Term Topics:** Each Term the children help decide a topic of focus that we centre learning, arts and crafts and other games and activities around. Some Term Topics for example have been Animals, Outer Space, Under the Sea, Nutrition, Dinosaurs, Countries around the world etc.



### All about Sports

Using the game sense approach, Peak Sports and Learning has developed a program that focuses on fundamental skill development through minor games. The focus of this approach is not just skill development; however the focus is on developing a child's understanding of the game. It has been proven that as a child's understanding of a game improves, it increases that child's enjoyment and their overall skill level. Minor games covering various sports will be used in a non-competitive environment.

Some examples of sports that are included in the program are: Soccer, Touch Football, Duster hockey, Rugby League, Golf, Dragon Tag, Basketball/Netball, Ultimate Frisbee, Dance, Gymnastics, Yoga, Athletics, Cheerleading, Volleyball, Hockey, Bocce, Cricket, Oz Tag, Hip Hop and more.



What if my child does not like sport? There are several reasons why some children do not like sports. These can include: Fear of failure; Lack of understanding; Peer pressure; Over competitive environment; Self-conscious; Undeveloped skills and limited sport choices.

Peak Sports and Learning recognises these reasons and has developed programs that break down these barriers and are inclusive for all. Programs will cater for elite sports children, whilst also catering for children will little or no sporting background. Children will be encouraged to participate in all forms of sport and physical activity where applicable. If your child is not enjoying or having difficulty with an activity, we will always offer alternate arrangements to better suit their needs and preferences.

As per the BASC Voucher terms and conditions, BASC Vouchers are non-transferrable between providers. However, in the case of a service transfer, the NSW Government is open to working with providers to ensure that parents do not lose the value of the BASC Vouchers.

For families that redeemed their Service NSW \$500 BASC Voucher with COOSH, any amounts remaining will be confirmed and transferred to Peak Sports & Learning in due course. This process will be completed directly between Peak (The provider) and Service NSW.
