

Camp Updates Stage 2

Hello,

Not long to go now. We have a few brief notes for you to pop on the fridge:

Medical Requirements

1. If you have indicated your child has a medical note on the original permission note you **MUST** complete the medical form sent to you at the end of last term.
2. If your child **unexpectedly** requires medical treatment at camp for an existing condition you **MUST** fill out the medical form prior to our departure.
3. All medicine needs to be handed to Miss Mountford on Monday, 12th November. It **MUST** be labelled clearly with the student's name and dosage.
4. The medical form has been loaded to the website with all other relevant information.

Behaviour

Being away from home can be difficult for all children but camp is a time that is busy, engaging and full of excitement and adventure. If your child has any worries please speak to the class teacher. We have been away many times with many children so there is nothing that we can't solve or manage discreetly.

It is expected that all students are respectful, responsible and follow our school's Core Values at all times. All students deserve privacy when showering and dressing and breaches of this will not be tolerated. Students who do not follow adult instructions, speak respectfully and demonstrate a positive attitude will follow the school's discipline policy. This could result in you being called to take them home. Please discuss this with your child. Light out and bed time are not negotiable. All cabin members deserve their sleep as do the supervising teachers.
